Chemical AST Regulations

The NYSDEC requires all chemical storage tanks to be tested during the initial installation and once every five years thereafter. Chemical ASTs with a capacity of 10,000 gallons or more must be inspected under the direction of a qualified engineer. Inspections must be conducted by a nationally recognized association or independent testing laboratory.



Petroleum AST Regulations

In accordance with the revised SPCC Rule 40CFR112, integrity testing must occur at regular intervals on all aboveground petroleum storage tanks at a facility that could reasonably discharge harmful quantities of oil into navigable water and has a single AST larger than 660 gallons of oil or a total AST capacity exceeding 1,320 gallons of oil.
