Stormwater discharges from certain construction activities are unlawful unless authorized by a State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) permit. NYSDEC requires permit coverage and stormwater inspections for construction activities disturbing an area of 1 acre or more.

Site Inspection Services

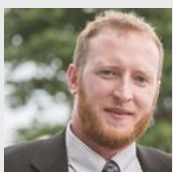
A qualified Inspector will conduct a site inspection for compliance with the appropriate erosion and sediment controls described in the SWPPP at least once every 7 calendar days.

Following each inspection, an inspection report will document the following information:

- A description of the condition of runoff at all points of discharge from the construction site.
- Identification and photographs of all erosion and sediment control practices that need repair or maintenance.
- Identification and photographs of all erosion and sediment control practices that were not installed properly or are not functioning as designed and need to be reinstalled or replaced.
- Description and sketch of areas that are disturbed at the time of the inspection and areas that have been stabilized since the last inspection.
- Current phase of construction of all post-construction stormwater management practices and identification of all construction that is not in conformance with the SWPPP and technical standards.
